

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How should I pack?

Each traveler is allowed one item of check-in luggage with a weight limit of 50 lbs and one small carry-on.

Due to the number of travelers and limited storage space on the busses, we require that all students limit their carry-on to the sports bag provided by the Group Leader.

The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) has mandated VERY strict carry-on guidelines with the 3-1-1 rule. Any item in question will be discarded by TSA. Go to www.tsa.gov for complete details.

What should I pack?

The weather on the east coast in Spring is unpredictable. We suggest you bring clothing you can layer. Also, we do quite a bit of site-seeing at night, so a warm coat and gloves are highly recommended. Pack a bathing suit — some of the hotels have indoor swimming pools.

Bring COMFORTABLE shoes! Sandles, flip-flops and high heels are highly discouraged. We do an extensive amount of walking.

We encourage you to bring snack items although you will be provided with three full meals a day.

How many guests are in a room?

No more than 4 guests are arranged to a room. Adults may request a single room for each hotel stay for an additional one-time trip fee.

Do I need to bring money?

All of your meals are included in your travel package with the exclusion of those incurred during flight. Bring cash to purchase food in airports/airplanes and any additional money you may desire for souvenirs and incidentals.

Any helpful hints?

- Pack light. You may be asked to load/unload your baggage from the busses.
- All shoes must be removed for xray screening. Wear shoes that can be easily removed.
- Get some sleep prior to departure and during the flight. We start our tour the moment we land.
- Bring disposable cameras with a mailing address on them.
